1) Showcases – plenary (3 minutes mini-presentations)

- Business success stories
- Innovation implementation success stories
- Environmental nutrient restoration success stories

2) Presentations for parallel sessions (15 minutes)

- **Economy**. Public economic policies and new business models to make nutrient sustainability or phosphorus recycling economically viable
- **Enhanced efficiency fertilisers**. Fertiliser companies selling yield improvement rather than tonnes of product.
- **Sustainable phosphorus removal**. Addressing the eutrophication challenge at a price society can pay. Marrying P-removal with P-recycling.
- R&D cooperation and platforms related to nutrient sustainability.
- Bringing recovered nutrient products to the market. Social acceptance. Farmers' preferences and requirements. Business models.
- **Phosphorus stewardship perspectives**. Policies. Indicators. Interactions with societal trends, climate change ...

3) Posters and stands

Can be on any of the themes above (1-2) or on any other theme relating to phosphorus
in different applications, phosphorus recovery or nutrient recycling, nutrient
sustainability, environmental impacts of nutrients, relevant public policies or business
models or societal trends ...

To candidate a presentation or poster, please send by email a 1- page WORD or PDF document including (in this order, in English):

- Specify: proposed presentation / flash presentation / poster ARIAL 11 italic
- Proposed talk title max 15 words ARIAL 14 bold
- Summary of talk content max 200 words ARIEL 11
- Name (format 'NAME Givenname' NAME in capitals, given name not in capitals), job title/position, organisation, country and email (obligatory) for lead author (name of <u>lead author</u> should be <u>underlined</u>) – ARIEL 9
- this same information for all co-authors ARIEL 9
- OPTIONAL: short list of key reference publications, websites or other sources of background and supplementary information (maximum = 6 items)
