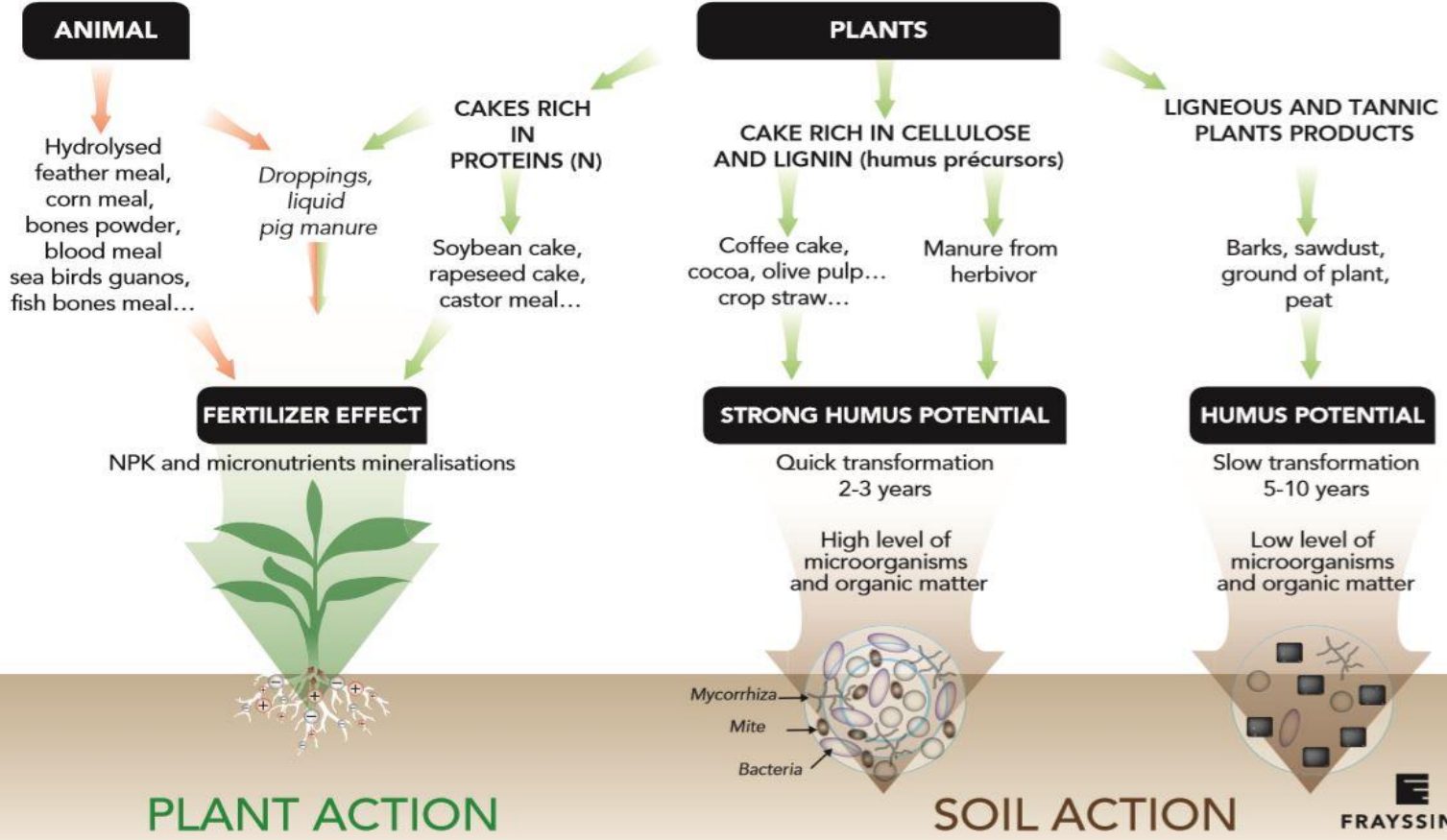

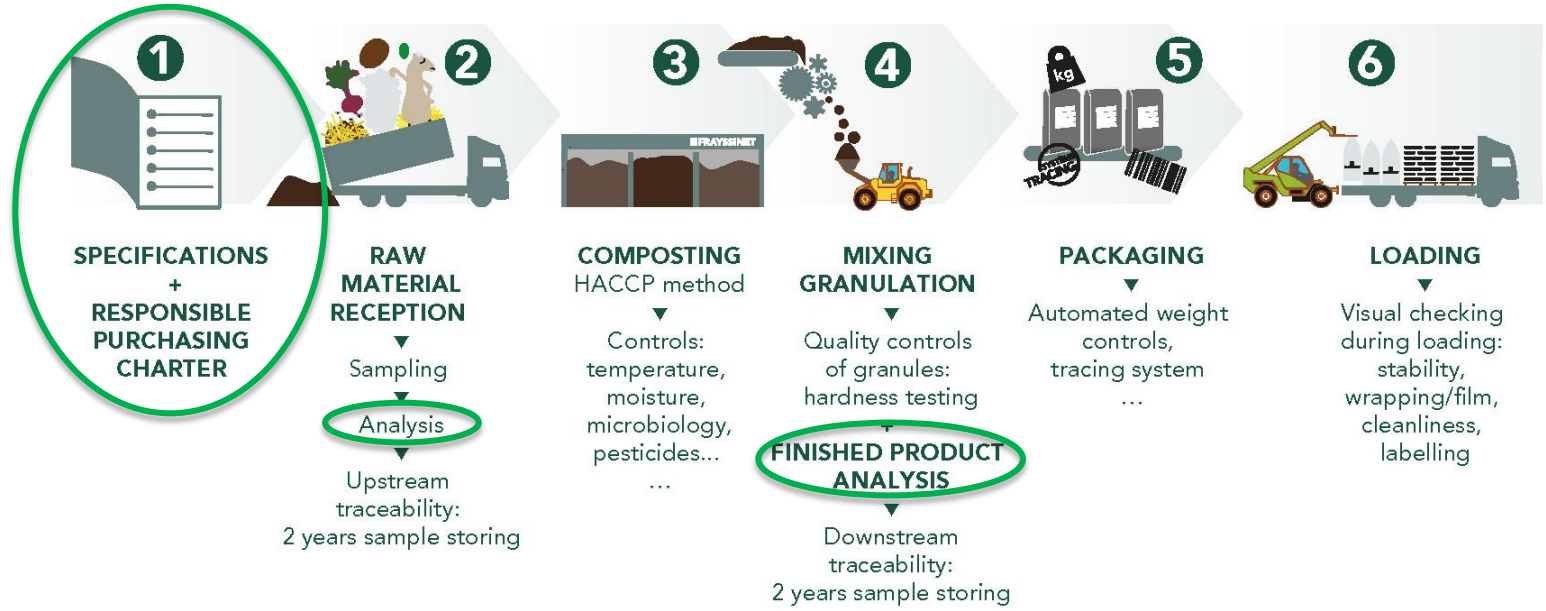

BIGGEST CONCERN ABOUT CMC 6 IN THE DRAFT REGULATION

Limitation and diminution of Food-industry by products supply sources by allowing only a positive list of raw material and heat or heat + mechanical transformation processes :

- **Doesn't promote Circular Economy** : By-products not in the scope of the regulation will be treated as waste or burnt instead of returning to the soil.

Example : Rapeseed cake obtained by Hexane extraction.

- **Puts a break on innovation and R&D** : As it will not help promoting more sustainable transformation processes if Food-industry can't valorize their by-products anymore.

Example : Use of agro-solvents (limonene for olive oil extraction).
